- World System
- Worlds Interests

1John 2:16

- Satisfying Our Desires and Physical Needs (To Excess)
- Satisfying Our Self-Esteem (Pride)

Luke 14:16-20

“Look, See, Prove, Enjoy”

- What We Find “From the Father” Will Never Draw Us Away from Him

Colossian 3:1-3

1John 2:17

- The World Will Cease (My World – Life)
- The World as We Know It Will Cease

2Peter 3:10-13

- Both Peter and John Make the Point Of Impermanence
- They Let Us Know That There Will Be a New Heaven and Earth
- This World Is Not A Place Where Righteousness Reigns

2. Antichrist Loves the World

1John 2:18,19

- Against Christ
- Will Come Out of a Religious Background
- They Were “Not of Us” – Not Saved, Not Born Again
- It Is “Plain” = To Render Apparent, To Make Manifest
- They Left and Are Anti-Christ
- They Love the World

1John 2:20,21

- You Have the Holy Spirit
- You Know the Truth from Lies

John 14:16,17

- The “World” Does Not Have, See or Know the Spirit
- How Do I Know I Am Saved?

- I Have the Spirit Of Truth!

1John 2:22,23

- Christ (The Original Anointed One) has no equal
- Old Testament Pictures of Anointing with Oil for Service Or Power, Point To, Foreshadow Jesus The Christ
- The Antichrist Denies This Truth
- People Who Say They Believe in God and Not in Jesus Have Neither

1John 2:24-26

- Why Would an Atheists Waste Their Time
- They Believe There Is No God
- You Know You Have Eternal Life
- You Are Confident in These Things

1John 2:27

- This Is About Who Is Teaching You
- Is The Spirit of Truth Teaching You?
- Is The Spirit of The World Teaching You?

John 14:23-26

3. Children of God Abide in Righteousness

1John 2:28

- How Can a Confessing Christian Sin Continually?
- They Will Be Miserable
- No Confidence in Seeing Christ
- John States “You May Have Confidence Today!”

1John 1:5-10

- Living In Righteousness Is an Awareness Of Our Sins
- Living In Righteousness Is Doing Something About It
- “Confess Our Sins”
- “He Is Faithful and Just” In His Righteousness
- He Will Cleanse Us, Because Only He Can

1John 2:29

- True God Recognizing, God Honoring Righteousness Comes from Him
- Through Us, In Him, Because We Have Been “Born of Him”
- John Says “Practice Righteousness”
